



Get Ready for Spring with 'Hook'

In the southern part of the country, growers are starting to spray Roundup and 24D for burn down. The main reason is that there is going to be weeds that Roundup alone will not get.

If you want to get a better kill, spray pattern, and drift control all in one product, consider **Hook**. When you use **Hook**, please do not add any other additive and be sure to 'Add **Hook** Last'.

We advise using 10 gal of water per acre with 1 qt of **Hook** per 100 gal. of spray. If you have bigger or hard to kill weeds go to 3 pts of **Hook** per 100 gal. Since we still have cool nights and showers this time of year you need a rain fastener. If you are using **Hook**---- it is built in. **Hook** is wash off resistant, guaranteed.

And before you forget, it's about time to get the ole spraying equipment out and check it over before doing any of that wheat spraying and applying burn down chemicals.

Without proper calibration and a good clean tank things are not going to work out very well.

First of all you need to check out the pump and tank. To get a good start I would wash out the spray tank with Atlantic-Pacific's **Work-Horse Tank Cleaner**. It will cut that old build up and also lube the pump.

The second thing is to get a good pressure check and a water test for leaks.

By the way, we published a good check list in CropLine # 11 and 12.

Everyone needs an edge for better control on weeds in the wheat and burn down and **Hook** is it.
