Corn is drying down and the insects are coming out and going to greener pastures.

One of my farmers has been having a lot of trouble with ‘plant bugs’ in his cotton that is growing next to corn. He has been spraying it weekly so I asked him if I could do a little test on that field and he agreed.

Now the weather here in Arkansas has been very wet, raining most every day, so we had to spray by airplane. We put “**HOOK**” in with his insecticide to see if we could get a longer ‘window’ before spraying again.

The farmer was worried about getting his crop sprayed in between rains. I told him all that we needed was 30 minutes of drying time with “**HOOK**”.

We sprayed Tuesday of last week and that night there was a big rain. I returned this week to look at the cotton and saw that not only did we get a good kill, but the cotton is still free of insects.

So what do we see here? “**HOOK**” makes the insecticide rainfast, gives it better insect control, and makes it longer lasting.

The cost? Less than a dollar an acre!!
